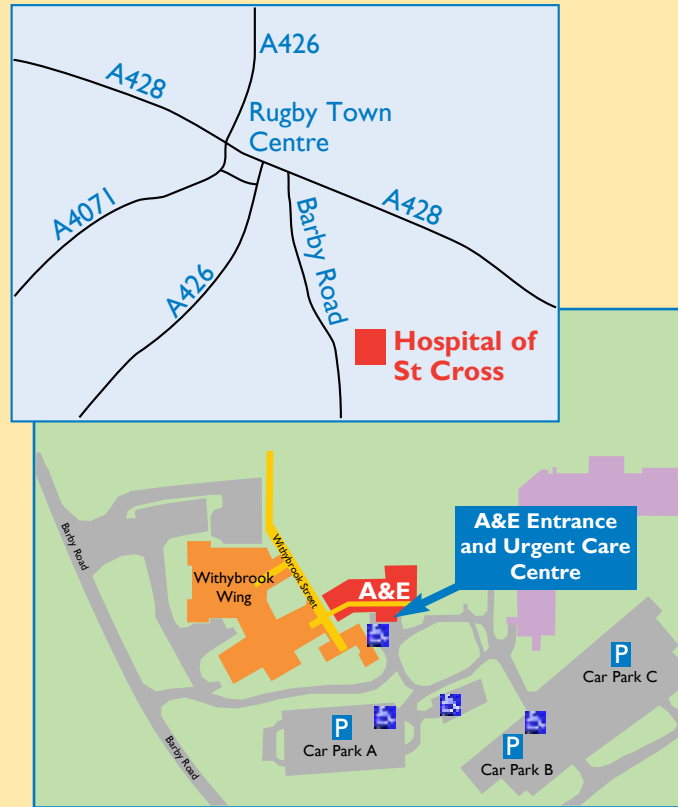

Emergency Department

The Emergency Department is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

The service is provided by doctors, nurses and advanced nurse practitioners.

The department will see adults with a wide range of emergency conditions. Some patients with more complex conditions may require transfer to and further treatment at University Hospital, Coventry (Walsgrave).
